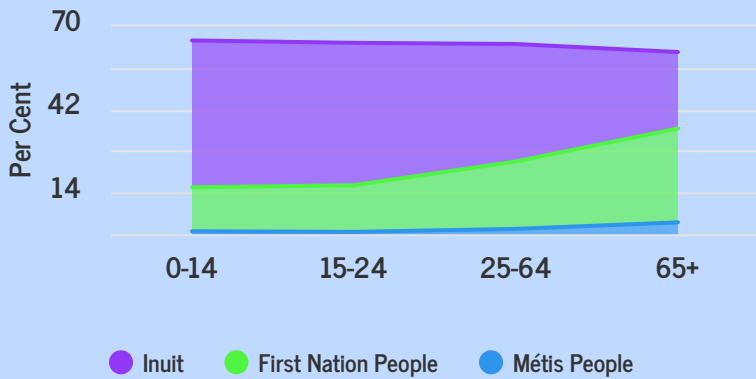


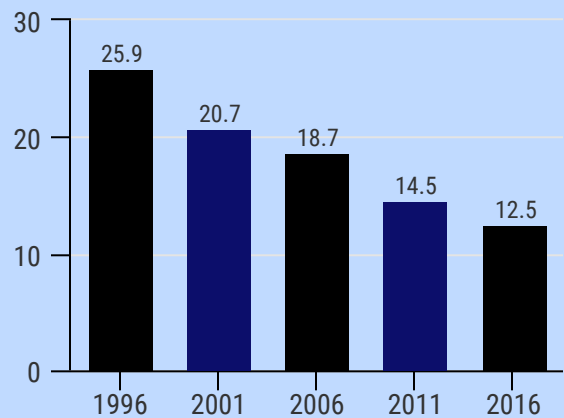

Ability to Conduct a Conversation in an Indigenous Language By Age (%)



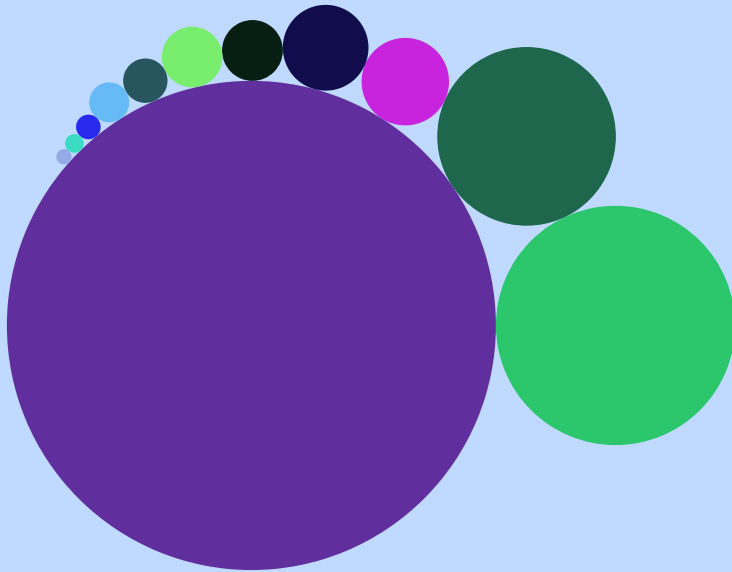
